 - 1. Whether Faith UMC adopts the Reconciling Statement proposed by the Love One Another Ministry (LOAM); and
 - 2. Whether Faith UMC will become affiliated with the Reconciling Ministries Network.

Several church-wide meetings have been held to explain the impact of the vote, and to answer questions. A link to read the Reconciling Statement is included in last Friday's What's Working at Faith.

The June 13th conference will be open to all professing members of the congregation, and all professing members in attendance can vote. Professing members include all people who have come into membership by profession of faith or by transfer from other churches. Attendees at the meeting constitute a quorum. No proxy votes will be taken.
